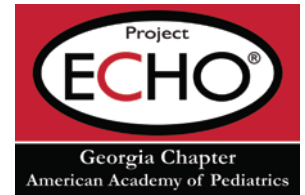


# Pediatric Growth & Endocrinology ECHO<sup>®</sup> Program

All pediatric clinicians & staff including: pediatricians, family physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, nurses, and medical assistants can participate. Topics covered: Growth Surveillance/Evaluation, Short Stature & GH Deficiency, Turners & Noonan Syndromes, Down & Prader- Willi Syndromes, Assessing Pubertal Development, and Communicating with Families & the Care Team.
