Overview

One of St. Luke's Children's Behavioral Health Services goals is to improve patient access to mental and behavioral health services in the primary care setting.

The REACH (Resources for Advancing Children's Health) course is a nationally recognized, three-day, intensive, integrative training for primary care providers that covers assessment, diagnosis, treatment and medication management for a variety of mental health conditions, including depression, anxiety, aggression, bi-polar and psychosis.

This course is intended to help primary care providers feel more comfortable with providing evidence based care appropriate to their level of training to children and families affected by mental illness.

Through the Cambia Health Foundation, we are able to provide the REACH, Primary Pediatric Psycho Pharmacology Course to 25 primary care providers.

The three-day course is followed by twice monthly conference calls, which include case study conversations with REACH faculty for the next 6 months.

Continuing Medical Education (CME) hours have been applied for.
