The Treasure Valley Regional Climate and Health Symposium brings together healthcare professionals, building operations teams and engineers to explore the intersection of climate change and health. Speaker panels will explore Idaho's three largest climate threats – heat, droughts and wildfires – through science, health implications and local community action.

This year, the symposium is held in honor of Terry O'Connor, MD, whose final work called us to recognize that climate is not separate from health, but central to it. Dr. O'Connor, who tragically passed away in an avalanche on May 10, 2024, was widely known across St. Luke's, the Wood River Valley, and the broader medical community as a devoted emergency physician, educator, storyteller, explorer, and environmental steward. Dr. O'Connor called us to recognize our role not only as caregivers, but as advocates and communicators at the intersection of climate and health.
