



INFANT TODDLER PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Infant Toddler Program provides early intervention services to assist Idaho children birth to age three who have a developmental delay or conditions (such as prematurity, Down Syndrome, hearing loss) that may result in a developmental delay. During the pandemic the program extended services virtually to reach Idaho children and families.

Services provided during COVID-19

- **03/23/2020**
Virtual services started two days prior to Idaho’s “stay at home” order.
- **03/16/2020 – 06/18/2020**
1,876 children received 3,928 virtual services.
- Therapy and case management services were provided primarily via videoconferencing and also telephonically.
