RE: Coronavirus (COVID-19) and Infant Toddler Program In-person Services

Effective June 14, 2021, the Idaho Infant Toddler Program will expand in-person/in-home early intervention services throughout the state of Idaho. We resumed limited in-person visits in June of 2020 for urgent-need cases and have steadily been increasing in-person services to families since that time.

With this upcoming change, we will be offering in-person visits for all our services. These services include:

- Evaluations and Assessments
- Intake Meetings
- Ongoing Early Intervention Home Visits
- Ongoing Service Coordination Home Visits
- Joint Visits

Depending on family preference and the needs of the child, families will have the option to receive telehealth services, in-person services, or a combination of both.

The enclosed brochure contains regional contact information and details about how to make a referral to the Idaho Infant Toddler Program. While children must meet eligibility criteria to receive Infant Toddler Program services, there is no cost to families for our services and they don't need insurance.
